



Provenance pushes pinot noir soap

Those looking to infuse their love for light-bodied reds and soap can rest easy – Provenance Hotels has combined forces with Pasadena-based Lather to roll out an exclusive line of soaps featuring local ingredients, including Oregon pinot noir.

The pinot noir soap also contains pink salt hand-harvested from the Oregon coast and is additionally infused with locally-sourced lavender essential oils sourced.

The two other soaps include a honey-oatmeal bar containing local honey and a peppermint bar with peppermint tea leaves harvested in Oregon and mint essential oil from Washington. All three soaps contain olive oil, shea butter, bamboo extract and Vitamin E.



Guests can find the soaps at the company's Pacific Northwest hotels – Seattle's Hotel Max and Portland's Hotel Lucia, Hotel deLuxe and Sentinel – over the first six months of 2017. The soaps will also be available at Provenance's new Hotel Theodore in Seattle and Dossier in Portland when both open in summer 2017. If guests want to take the soaps to go, a set of three 1.6 oz. bars will be available for purchase in the guestroom honor bars later this year.
