More than 80 of the hotel partners are in Canada, including recent deals with Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise, Lakeview Resorts & Hotels, Bellstar Hotels & Resorts and Canalta Hotels.

In less than two years, Clean the World has collected and distributed more than 6 million soap bars to families in need throughout the United States and more than 40 countries worldwide, including 1.5 million soap bars to Haiti.
